



Digital Risk Checklist for New Devices

- Factory reset / fully wipe your old device
- Turn on two-factor authentication for Apple ID, or whatever email address you're using to sign in to your new device
- Turn on automatic backup / sync to Apple iCloud / Google to backup important information like contacts, calendar data, photos, local files, etc. (after turning on two-factor authentication for your sign in account)
- Download and install a password manager, like LastPass or 1Password
- Download and install a VPN, like ExpressVPN or NordVPN
- Download and install an authentication app like Authy or Google Auth
- Set up a PIN, Face ID, password, or whatever method is available for locking your device when not in use
- Add two-factor authentication to any applications or accounts which contain sensitive data (social media accounts, banking apps, insurance applications, etc.)
- If you plan to use your device for work, check with your IT department about Bring Your Own Device policies or additional endpoint security measures required
